New glass recycling round launched!

TLM has launched its new glass recycling round!

The new lorry will be taking to the road June 2017, complete with digital tracking and friendly driver to empty recycling bins across various sites in Essex.

We empty the 240ltr containers from customers sites and then our lorry takes it to a specialized glass recycling facility. The glass is then sorted and washed to remove any residue and impurities before being sorted by a machine into different colors and then

crushed and melted into new products such as bottles and jars or decorative items. The glass then goes back onto the shelves and cupboards and the cycle begins again!

The energy saved from recycling one bottle would power one 100 watt light bulb for almost

an hour or a computer for 20 minutes!

This type of recycling is known as the 'closed loop' system. Glass does not degrade whilst its going through the recycling process so the process can go round again and again.

Other than the obvious recycling benefits, customers may benefit financially as having a dedicated glass bin would make their general waste bins lighter and therefore they would be paying less in weight and may even be able to down size in container.

New Recycling Facility Opened in Basildon

The start of 2017 brought the full opening of TLM's new yard in Basildon.

The 2 acres of land, based in Hovefields Avenue in Basildon, now houses TLM's

multiple recycling sheds, weighbridge and offices as well as an impressive fleet of vehicles including an FEL, dustcarts, skip lorries, roll on roll offs, 7.5 tonne lorries and articulated vehicle.

As well as general waste, TLM have separate sheds to sort and process cardboard, paper and metal too. We are fully licensed to accept asbestos and have designed bays and trained ADR staff to hand.
